Opening Day Sail Past Sequence – 2024

14:00 hrs (approximate)

The Sail Past signifies the opening of the season at Blairgowrie Yacht Squadron and is characterized by the tradition of inspecting the Club's vessels by the Commodore.

When sailing past the stern of the Commodore's vessel, it is tradition to call "Three cheers for the Commodore! Hip hip hooray. Hip hip hooray."

The Commodore's vessel will be moored on the Clubhouse side of the starting line between BYS0 and BYS 1.

Boats sailing past the Commodore's vessel will sail from West to East past the stern, and then wait outside the starting area until the sail past has completed. Keelboats and powerboats will be directed via VHF radio, OTB will be directed via class flags on a RIB.

Please try to stay with your fleet/class as much as possible.
