WELCOME TO BYS & THE PETERSVILLE REGATTA!

Welcome to the Blairgowrie Yacht Squadron and Marina, and thank you for choosing to berth with us on the beautiful Mornington Peninsula. BYS is one of Victoria's strongest and most vibrant sailing clubs and our facilities are state of the art. Our clubhouse provides food and beverage services, with one of the best views to Port Phillip Bay.

MARINA AND FACILITY ACCESS (for non-members of BYS)

Access to the harbour is via security-activated gates located at the end of each arm. One regatta access card is enclosed in this Welcome Pack for your use during the event. Additional crew access cards will be issued for your boat at regatta registration. During clubhouse open hours you are also welcome to use the showers and toilet in the Junior Lounge located on the ground floor of the clubhouse.

You have 24/7 access to toilets, showers and laundry facilities, available in the building behind Scotts' Shed, on the first floor (Building closest to the marina).

MARINA RULES

On our website under "Marina" you will find our Marina Rules. Please take the time to read them. A simple summary is also attached. We are an accredited Marina Industry Association "Clean Marina" and are the first in Victoria to receive Fish Friendly status. We operate under an approved Operational Environment Management Plan, a copy of which is also on our website.

CHECK OUT

Check out time is 10am. Note any boat that has not vacated on the morning of the agreed date will be charged double the standard nightly rate.

REGATTA PASSES WHERE TO RETURN

Please ensure that upon departure, your regatta passes are dropped into the **silver letter** boxes found at the end of each arm, near the marina gates (underneath the black drop boxes). A \$50 fee per card will be charged to your credit card if the cards are not returned on the day of departure.

SERVICES

Water and electricity are available to each berth, visitors are required to provide their own 15amp electrical leads and water hoses. We also have a pump out facility on the eastern side of the public pier. To arrange this service please contact the Marina Office.

Please note we do not offer fuel, the nearest locations are Queenscliff and Martha Cove.

SECURITY

The Marina and Pier are under continuous CCTV surveillance. However for security reasons, please ensure that all removable items are securely locked away when you are not using your boat.

EXTENDING YOUR STAY

If you need to extend your rental period please contact the Marina Office with your new intended departure date BEFORE your current end date, to ensure we haven't booked the berth to another tenant. Email marina@bys.asn.au or phone during office hours. Double the normal rate will be charged for boats that have not vacated.

NEARBY SHOPS AND SERVICES

Approximately 300m east of the club on Point Nepean Road is the Blairgowrie Shopping Centre. Offering a supermarket, pharmacy, medical clinic and a variety of in-house or take-away dining options.

CAR PARKING

There is free parking on the access road leading down to the clubhouse off Point Nepean Road and in the carpark nearest to the marina office directly off Pont Nepean Road, access is via steps behind Scott's Shed.

Pick-up and drop-off of bulk goods may be arranged, please see the marina office. Trolleys and wheelbarrows are available for use and are located in the carpark next to the main clubhouse.

BYS MARINA RULES – QUICKGUIDE

WHY WE HAVE MARINA RULES

- To ensure the safety, amenity and peace of mind of all marina occupants.
- We care about our marine environment
- We are required to, under our Planning Permit and approved Operating Environment Management Plan

SUMMARY OF SOME KEY RULES

- Maximum speed in the marina is 5 knots, walking speed. Do not create any wash or wake
- Keep right in the fairways
- No litter of any kind over the side – please take your litter to the skips in the car park
- BYS discourages the use of single use plastics
- No discharge from any sink, shower or toilet. You must have a holding tank on board for all liquid disposal
- No major works, maintenance works, or in water cleaning is allowed
- Any spillage or leakage of any fuel or contaminated bilge water, grey or black water is to be reported to the Marina Manager immediately
- No fishing or fish cleaning is allowed within the Marina
- No overhangs or items such as bicycles or sails to be left on the main walkways
- Ropes, hoses, leads etc. not in use are to be stored carefully on the finger not the walkway
- All boats must be registered and insured
- Any damage to the marina or another boat is to be reported to the Marina Manager immediately
- Security of all vessels is the responsibility of the pen occupant. The pen occupant is responsible for all lines and fenders
- Only inducted contractors registered with BYS may work on boats in the marina or BYS yard
- The Marina Manager is responsible for all decisions regarding the application of the rules
