

## By-law

Title:	Car Parking at BYS

## **Explanatory note:**

The BYS car park and hardstand areas are vitally important assets with limited capacity. Access and use of these areas for the parking of vehicles is subject to strict conditions designed to ensure safe, fair and unhindered access to all using them.

The primary function of the hardstand is to provide a secure and organized area for the storage, launching, and maintenance of sportsboats and related marina activities. It is not designed or intended to function as a car park.

For those reasons, the Executive Committee makes the following By-law:

## By-Law – Car Parking at BYS

- 1. BYS may grant car park access to eligible Members on an annual basis each BYS Year.
- 2. The fee payable for car park access shall be determined by the Manager.
- 3. Flag Officers, Executive Committee members and other Members as the Manager determines may be granted car park access at a reduced or no charge.
- 4. Upon payment of the applicable fee, the Member will be issued with a car park sticker and their membership card will be granted access to the car park boom gate. The car park sticker must be affixed to the vehicle windscreen in a prominent position on the driver's side.
- 5. No more than two eligible membership cards per car park pass will be granted access to the car park boom gate.
- 6. Members granted car park access may park in the club grounds, subject to space being available. No vehicle is to be left in a position that blocks the circulation of vehicles through the car park.
- 7. Parking is not permitted in bays reserved for specified officeholders or in a manner that blocks access to the Marina or emergency access.
- 8. Membership cards and car park stickers are not transferable.

- 9. If a Member parks in a tandem park in front of an already parked vehicle, they must leave their vehicle unlocked and the keys under the front seat so that their vehicle may be moved to allow the vehicle behind to leave. If a Member does not wish to leave their keys in their vehicle, do not park in front of a vehicle in a tandem space.
- 10. The hardstand and the runway are not to be used for general or Member vehicle parking at any time. Vehicles are prohibited from being left on the hardstand or the runway unless expressly permitted by the Marina Manager.
- 11. Members with car park access may temporarily bring their vehicles onto the hardstand to load or unload equipment directly to or from their boat. Vehicles must be moved off the hardstand immediately after the task is completed.
- 12. Inducted employees of service providers may be granted access to the hardstand by the Marina Manager. Contractors will not have access to the hardstand over weekends or during sailing events at BYS, unless approved by the Marina Manager.
- 13. Any vehicle left unattended on the hardstand or runway without prior authorisation from the Marina Manager may be subject to removal at the owner's cost.
- 14. During regattas, training, or other events, the hardstand must remain clear of vehicles to support efficient and safe operations of boats, trailers, and crane use. Members and contractors must plan vehicle movements accordingly.
- 15. Trailers are not to be left in the car park or on the lawn except while loading and unloading boats.
- 16. Breach of this by-law, including a Member parking a vehicle without having been granted car park access, may result in disciplinary action, including withdrawal of car park or hardstand access, or hardstand storage rights.
