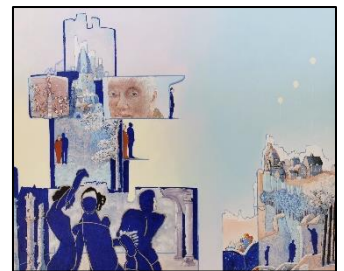
It's really challenging to capture waves in paint, fluid movement of the waves is captured with impressive colours.

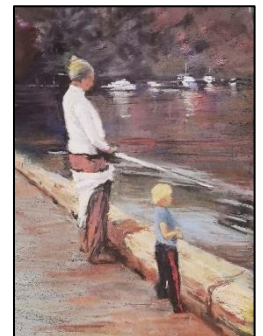
Combining paint and collage is interesting telling multiple stories. It is very compelling and complex.

Creative use of colour, it's a soft, gently and delicate painting which creates an intimacy between the two people in the painting.

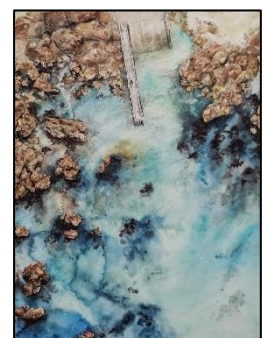

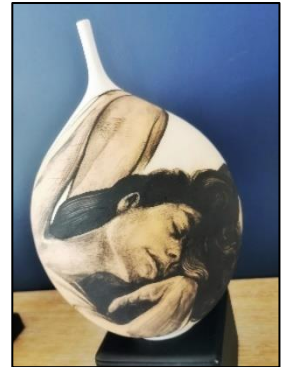
